## Cookies

### What are cookies and how does Hartman use them?

Cookies are small data information files that are stored during a visit to our website on the device where you visit our website, such as a computer, tablet, smartphone or smartwatch.

What we are talking about "cookies" below, we refer to other similar techniques.

Cookies make it possible to recognize your web browser. In this way we can operate our website better, we can gain insight into the visitor behavior on the website and other parties can gain insight into your surfing behavior, so that they can show personalized advertisements about multiple websites and can leave non-relevant advertisements.

Hartman uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies:

#### ***Functional cookies***

These cookies are necessary for the proper functioning of our website. For example, they make sure that the desired information is displayed quickly and accurately each time you visit our website. No authorization is required to place functional cookies.

#### ***Analytical cookies***

We use these cookies for the analysis of our website. For example, we would like to know how often you visit our website and which pages you click on. These analytical cookies do not have a great impact on privacy, so no permission needs to be requested.

### ***Tracking cookies***

These cookies can follow your browsing behavior on our website. In this way, advertisers can display personalized online advertisements based on their browsing habits. We ask your permission to place these cookies. On your first visit to our website, we have already informed you about these cookies and have asked you for permission to place them.

## **Privacy**

### **How does Hartman obtain your personal data?**

Hartman has data about you because you have provided us with that information. This can be done by subscribing to newsletters, participating in promotions or by other means. Hartman will always ask for authorization to use your data.

### **What personal data does Hartman process?**

Hartman can process the following personal data:

### **How long does Hartman store personal data?**

Hartman will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within a period of approximately four weeks.

### **Receivers of personal data and transmission to third parties**

Hartman will not sell your data to third parties and will only provide it if necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. With companies that process your data in our assignment,

and we closed with them an agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. Hartman remains responsible for these processing operations.
